Once again the Gateway Region has built upon its long tradition of caring and giving. Despite facing one of the most challenging and uncertain financial climates in modern history, federal employees of the Gateway Region contributed \$2,972,891 to the fall 2012 Combined Federal Campaign (CFC). Donations exceeded the \$2.9 million goal by nearly \$73,000. The typical donor's contribution was \$339.

As detailed in this report, pledges were received from 8,759 employees and will benefit countless individuals through the worthy offerings of the 1,761 different charitable organizations designated by donors. The impact of these donations will help tens of thousands of people.

The generosity of the Gateway Region is extraordinary and it has been my privilege to serve as the Chair of its CFC Leadership Committee. 
